R 403.10 Pools and permanently installed Spas (M)

**R – 403.10.1** Heaters – Readily accessible on-off switch mounted on the exterior of the heater or within 3 feet. The switch does not change the setting of the thermostat. Gas fire heaters will not have a continuously burning ignition pilot.

**R 403.10.2** Time Switches - Time switches or other control methods that can automatically turn off and on according to a preset schedule will be installed for heaters and pump motors.

**Exceptions**: where 24-hour health standards require otherwise. Pumps that operate solar and wastewater heat recovery pool heating systems.

**R – 403.10.3** Covers - Outdoor heated pools and Spas will provide a vapor retarder cover or other vapor retarder means.

**Exception**: Where 70 % or more of the heat is generated by a solar or heat recovery system, a vapor retarder system is not required.

**R – 403. 11 Permanent Spas (M)** - Controls will meet APSP 14 requirements

**R – 403.12** Residential pools and permanent residential spas - Pools and spas that service one and two-family dwellings and townhouses less than 3 stories where the pool or spa is only available to the household and guest will be in accordance with ASPS-15
